National Philanthropy Day® (NPD) is a special day designated each year to recognize the great contributions of philanthropy -- and those individuals, corporations and foundations that are active in the philanthropic community and enrich our world.

National Philanthropy Day® provides an opportunity to reflect on the meaning of giving and all that it has made possible. First held in 1986, NPD celebrates the endless daily contributions individuals and organizations across the world make to countless causes and missions. Last year, more than 100 AFP chapters held NPD events and activities.

As the AFP Chapter President-Elect, I will organize and facilitate the nomination process, which has been predetermined by AFP International. Attached you will find this year's nomination applications. Forms are also available on our local website (www.afppbc.org).

The nomination categories are: Outstanding Philanthropic Private Foundation, Outstanding Philanthropic Corporation/Organization, Outstanding Philanthropic Corporate Foundation, Outstanding Philanthropist, Outstanding Volunteer Fundraiser and Outstanding Planned Giving/Legacy Honoree. A complete list of all past honorees follows this memo. Past honorees are not eligible for re-nomination for the local chapter AFP award. However, past honorees can be nominated for an International Award. Please contact me for details on this process.

Nominations will be accepted only from current/active members of the Palm Beach County Chapter of AFP. Please include your member number on the application. As has been approved by our chapter, the Planned Giving/Legacy Award Nomination may be submitted by an AFP or a Planned Giving Council Member.

Complete the nomination forms using the format and guidelines established for each category. Please type your nomination if possible. Handwritten submissions will be accepted if they are neat and legible. Requested information must be complete and accurate. The Committee will eliminate from consideration those materials that do not adhere to the basic requirements and/or the specific guidelines for each category. In the past, some AFP members have co-nominated an individual or organization. This can be an excellent collaboration of efforts so please consider this option with a fellow AFP member who has also received gifts from your prospective nominee. If two or more organizations nominate the same individual, corporation or foundation that is chosen as an awardee, all organizations will be recognized in as a nominator.

I will then announce the honorees in each category the following week so that the NPD Chairs and Public Relations Chair can begin their media blitz.
