

The winner of the **2016 Lasting Legacy Award** is a charitable trust that was established by its late benefactor in 1995, naming Indian River State College as one of its beneficiaries. For the past 20 years, the trust has provided funding ranging from \$7,000 to \$10,000 on an annual basis. The funds have been used to support programs and campaigns to benefit several different areas of the college.

Projects supported include scholarships and capital campaigns at the Florida State University College of Medicine at Indian River State College; Treasure Coast Public Safety Training Complex; Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Center; and the Wolf High-Technology Center in Stuart.

In 2015, the trustee notified Indian River State College that it would be receiving a large payout of the charitable remainder trust, receiving a check for \$185,082 along with agreement of the trustee that the funds would be endowed and used for scholarships for students pursuing careers in the human services field.

In summary, the thought and foresight of this generous individual has provided legacy gifts to date of \$447,062 since 1995 to benefit the college and its students through this charitable remainder trust.
