

The winners of the **2016 Living Legacy Award** are a couple, who are longtime residents of St. Lucie County and the husband is the president of well-known law firm with offices in Fort Pierce, Viera, Gainesville, Tallahassee and Tampa. He has also served as a member of the IRSC Foundation Board of Directors since 1994, setting an exemplary example to his company's 100 employees by donating his time, legal services and initiating fundraising efforts for scholarships.

Strong supporters of education, this philanthropic couple makes annual gifts to provide tuition for deserving low-income students through the Take Stock in Children Scholarship Program, always attending the annual award ceremony and they enjoy meeting the students whose scholarships they are supporting. After graduation, recipients receive four years of tuition – 2 years at IRSC and 2 years at IRSC or another Florida State College.

In addition to providing outstanding support to IRSC during their lifetimes, this couple has made provisions to include IRSC in their estate plan through the distribution of IRA and 401(K) funds. Other non-profits to receive bequests include Harbor Branch Oceanographic Institute, University of Florida Foundation and St. Edward's School. Their support is estimated to be valued at one million dollars, with the plan for the funds to be used for scholarships at each of the educational institutions.
