Each Family Nurse Consultant has the ability to create a safety net of resources to support and assist patients and families throughout their relationships. Family Nurse Consultants help thousands through telephone, office and home visit contact. They will tackle the tough issues *for* you.

The Role of the Alzheimer's Community Care Family Nurse Consultant:

- See to the immediate safety of both patient and caregiver
