Presented to a currently active senior volunteer who has demonstrated exceptional involvement and dedication in helping other seniors in his or her community.



CALIDUS Management *Volunteer of the Year Award*

Presented to an active senior volunteer involved in making a difference with a nonprofit in Palm Beach, St. Lucie, Martin, Okeechobee or Indian River County.



Florida Power & Light *Community Service Award*

Presented to a currently active senior volunteer involved with one or more non-profit organization(s) or program(s). This recipient has helped to address a public need or cause that has had a positive impact on the community as a whole.
