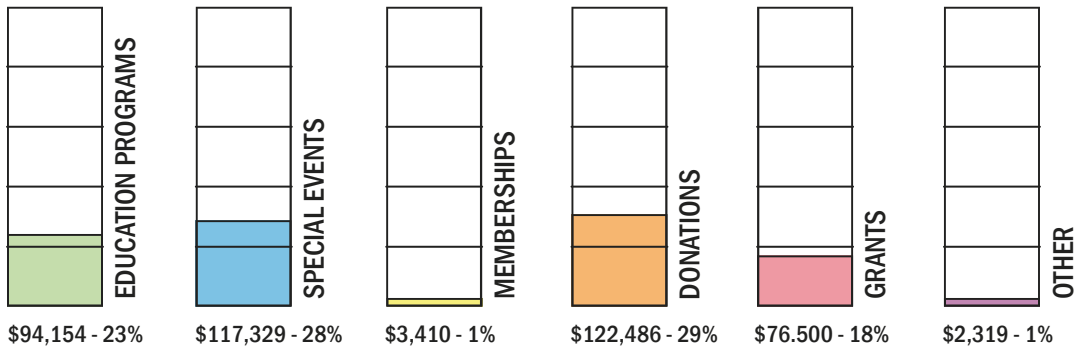

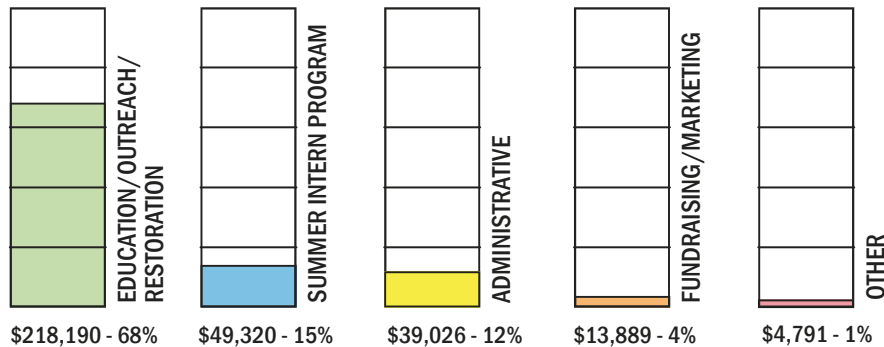

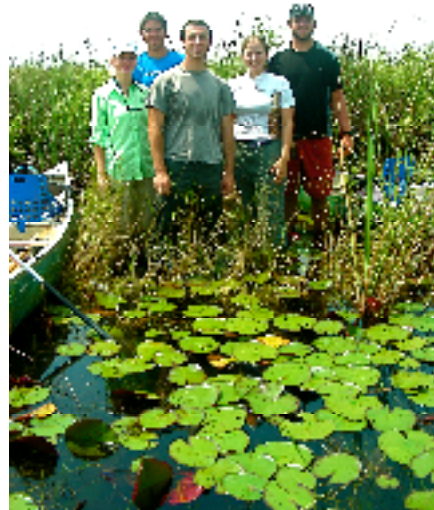
2010 Highlights

The Marshall Foundation internship is an intensive, 11-week course on the Florida Everglades and its massive restoration effort open to college students majoring in environmental and related sciences. The 39 graduates since the program began in 2002 have learned about the ecology, hydrology, and history of the Everglades, mentored by professionals from government, scientific, and non-profit communities. Summer Interns also have the opportunity to explore environmental careers.
