- 2) Transcripts: include past and current university transcripts with GPA's (unofficial copies ok)
- 3) High-level Term Paper: thesis papers also accepted, this paper must be authored by you individually (no team projects please)
- 4) Resume: including all experiences that relate to the environment
- 5) Other: please feel free to include any other information you think may be pertinent

Requirements & Expectations

- Once the program begins on May 18, 2012, interns are expected to complete the program through the close-out date of Aug 3, 2012.
- Since this program involves working on a multi-disciplinary team, interns are expected to complete the program and will not have time for engaging in other coursework.
- This is a full time internship (minimum of 5 days a week, 8 hours a day, and some week-end time for field work and travel to view various parts of the Everglades ecosystem).
- Interns are paid a stipend.
- Room and board is the responsibility of the intern although some assistance in locating housing can be expected from the Arthur R. Marshall Foundation.
- The program involves rigorous field work in the South Florida Everglades ecosystem during the hottest and rainiest time of year.

Selection Committee Criteria

- Major area of study with intent to pursue a career in environmental sciences and related fields
- Grade point average greater than 3.0
- Letters of recommendation
- Graduate/Undergraduate status, upper classmen and graduate students are given priority
- Resume
- Written and verbal communication skills
- Timely application received no later than close of business March 31, 2012
- Final selection will be based on a "total person view" that considers all the above and a face-to-face interview with the selection committee. For those too distant, interview by SKYPE is a viable option.
