

RESOLUTION NO. R-86-1354

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT ON THE NOVEMBER 4, 1986 GENERAL ELECTION OF A BALLOT QUESTION AUTHORIZING THE LEVYING OF TAXES ON BEHALF OF THE CHILDREN'S SERVICES COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, Chapter 86-196, Laws of Florida, authorizes each County of the State to create an independent special district to provide juvenile welfare services throughout the County in accordance with said act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it would serve the public interest to establish said independent special district; and

WHEREAS, the funding of said district may be by the levy of ad valorem taxes annually on all taxable property in the County in an amount not to exceed one half mill provided that the Authority to levy such taxes has been approved by a majority vote of the electors of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that

1. The Supervisor of Elections is directed to place on the November 4, 1986 General Election the following question to be voted upon by the electors of Palm Beach County:

Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County
Ad Valorem Authorization

"Shall the Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County be granted the authority to fund the improvement of children's developmental, health and other juvenile welfare services by the levying each year of an ad valorem tax not to exceed one-half (1/2) mill for services for children?"
