Bicycle helmets reduce the risk of serious head injury by as much as 85 percent, studies show. Yet more than half of the children in the United States don't wear a helmet. Many of them don't even have one.

That's why Safe Kids Palm Beach County needs your help.

We are the area's leading organization in distributing free helmets to families in need. Safe Kids Palm Beach County has given out about 10,000 helmets in just the last five years. The demand for helmets is now greater than ever.

We are asking for you to join our new helmet campaign — "Use Your Head. Wear a Helmet." The money you or your business contribute to Safe Kids Palm Beach County, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit group, will go directly to our helmet program.
