When is GOLD upgrading to MyTeachingStrategies™?

Starting on 4/3/17, MyTeachingStrategies™ will be your new entry-point for accessing GOLD® and any other Teaching Strategies digital classroom tools and resources that you use.

There's no action needed on your part - you'll simply log in using your existing GOLD® username and

password, which will bring you to the upgraded user interface. You'll continue to find all the tools and resources you need to support your assessment process in the "Assess" area of MyTeachingStrategies™, along with all your existing documentation and data.

How to prepare for MyTeachingStrategies™

To ensure that your upgrade to MyTeachingStrategies is seamless and that you know where to look and how to find what you need, Teaching Strategies is making MyTeachingStrategies available for you to explore. You should receive access to a preview version of MyTeachingStrategies within your GOLD® account. We encourage you to take this opportunity to practice using the features of the upgraded platform, which you can do without affecting any data for the children in your class.

A few things to know about the MyTeachingStrategies™ preview environment

- The preview environment is exactly that - an opportunity for you to preview the features and functionalities of MyTeachingStrategies™. This preview is not linked to your actual GOLD® account and any data entered within the preview environment will not be saved or transferred to your upgraded account.
- We encourage you to explore all of the great features available to you, but recommend waiting until you have access to your upgraded account before completing your Interrater Reliability Certification or any of the courses found within the Develop area. The work completed in these areas will not be saved to your upgraded account.
- If you don't immediately see data in some of the reports - don't worry! Some reports are refreshed at regular intervals and will take some time to populate after you first log in to the preview.
- The preview environment features expanded birth through third grade objectives for development and learning. When you first upgrade, you'll continue to use the birth through kindergarten objectives, ensuring that your data is consistent throughout the school year. We'll help your program transition to the birth through third grade objectives before you start the 2017-2018 school year, but we hope you enjoy this sneak peek of the expanded progressions!



About *MyTeachingStrategies*™

The Dashboard & 5 main areas of *MyTeachingStrategies*™

When you sign into *MyTeachingStrategies*™, you will be taken to your personal DASHBOARD. The dashboard provides important personalized communications to help you get the most out of your *MyTeachingStrategies*™ digital tools.

1. The **TEACH** area provides planning functionality to help you link your assessment data with instruction. Here you'll find weekly and monthly planning calendars and digital curriculum assets. You can also research articles or find "filler" articles by accessing the World Wide Web.
2. In the **ASSESS** area you'll find everything you need to enter assessment information for the children in your classroom. Here you can view and add documentation, and input your checkpoint data.
3. In the **DEVELOP** area you'll find the Interrater Reliability certification as well as, My Courses. This provides access to your online professional development courses. As well as, *The Objectives for Development and Learning* course is included with your **GOLD**® subscription.
4. When you enter the **REPORT** area, you'll see a menu of all available reports. You will be able to select the INFORMATION ICON to see a description of each report.
5. Within the **FAMILY** area, you will be able to access Family Conference Forms and other family connections

Accessing *MyTeachingStrategies*™

As of April 3rd, 2017, when you sign in, make sure you have the username and password that you use for your current GOLD account.

To log in, go to TeachingStrategies.com and click the LOGIN button at the top, right-hand side of the screen.

When the sign in screen appears, enter your username and password. Then click SUBMIT.

Important Dates

Checkpoint Deadlines 2016-2017

We are now in the documentation window for Spring checkpoint (February 15, 2017- May 17, 2017). This is the time allocated for teachers to observe and document children's learning and complete connections and preliminary levels based on what is observed. From May 17, 2017- May 31, 2017, teachers will finalize levels. During this checkpoint period, teachers will make final determinations about how to level a child based on the evidence in each objective/ dimension. The checkpoint period closes on May 31, 2017 at midnight.

Teacher's Guide to Gold Training
