

Using Madeira thread on the AMAYA

The following are tips on using Madeira thread on the AMAYA

-when using the 1,100 yard spools of Madeira thread on the AMAYA please use the spool/cone holder from Madeira (part number 100-7). This will eliminate the possibility of the thread getting underneath the spool causing a thread breaks due to lack of thread in the feed system.



-take and slide the spool/cone holder down over the thread tube guide on the AMAYA



-pull the white plastic thread tube tip up



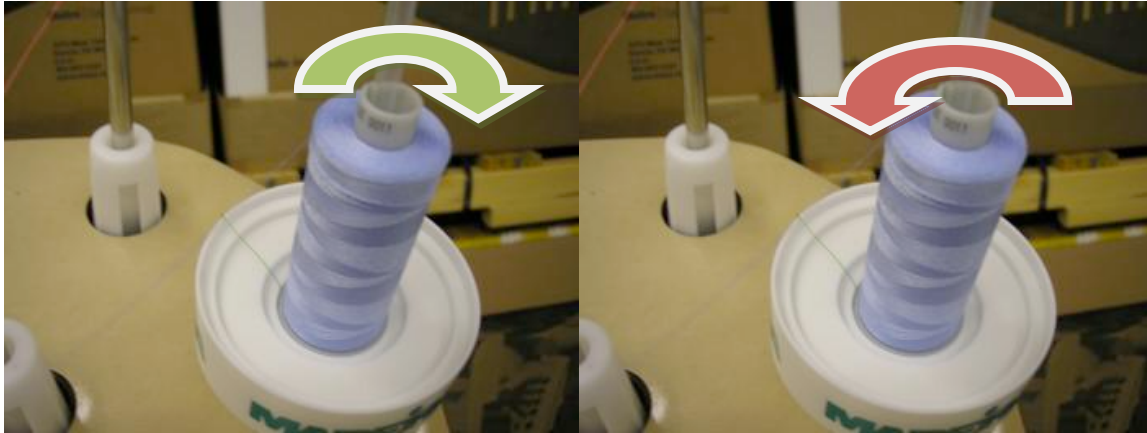
-take and slide the spool of Madeira thread on and seat it into the spool/cone holder



-push the white plastic thread tube tip down to where it is approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ " above the top of the spool of thread



Note: it is important that the thread comes off of the spool clockwise. If it does not take the spool off, remove the small disk on the bottom of the spool and put it on the top. Now the bottom has become the top and the thread should come off clockwise

-When using the large cones of Madeira thread please use the Thread Cone Clovers from Melco ([part number 33820](#))



-Take and slide the thread cone cover onto the thread tree guide tube



-pull the white plastic thread tube tip up



-take and slide the cone of Madeira thread down over the thread cone cover until the base of the cone of thread is resting against the base of the thread pallet



-push the white plastic thread tube tip down to where it is approximately ¼" above the top of the spool of thread



Note: Some older Madeira cones may not set all the way down on the rubber base of the AMAYA. To make sure that this does not cause thread break issues it is important to use the spool/cone holder from Madeira and the thread tree clover from Melco
