Parent InfoLine Offers Support to Palm Beach County Families

Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County believes confident parents raise healthy, safe and strong children. That's why the Council recently launched its free **Parent InfoLine** that is available to all Palm Beach County residents raising children.

Through the InfoLine, Parent Resource Representatives listen to parents and caregivers, who may be wondering about their child's growth and development; share helpful information; offer strategies to encourage positive child behavior; and help parents locate resources within their community.

The end goal? Strengthening the parent-child relationship.

The InfoLine is available weekdays from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Parents who call after hours can leave a message to receive a return call. The service is confidential and available in English, Spanish and Creole.

Children's Services Council, an independent district established by Palm Beach County voters in 1986, provides leadership, funding and research on behalf of the county's children, so they are born healthy, growing up safe, ready to learn when they enter school and on grade level by the end of third grade.
