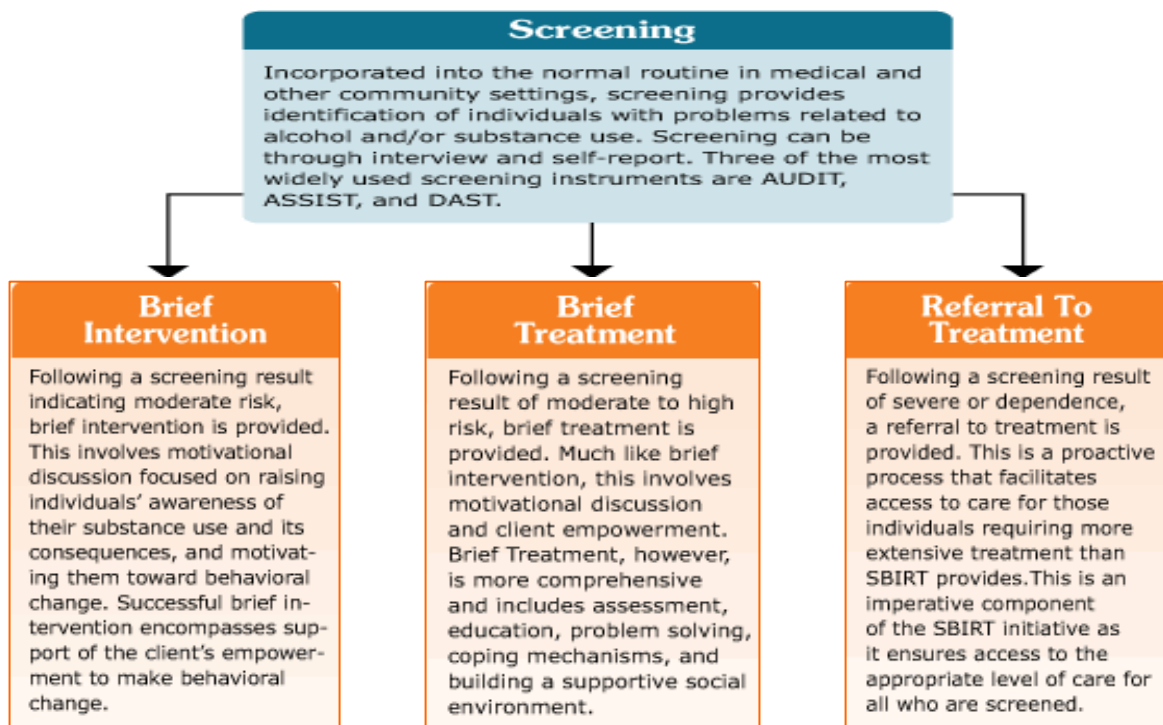




SBIRT is a national evidence-based initiative for **S**creening, **B**rief **I**ntervention, and **R**eferral to **T**reatment for substance abuse.

In Broward County, SBIRT is being administered by a number of health care and community providers to address substance abuse risk and abuse in individuals ages 14 to 30.

The SBIRT Model includes...



The SBIRT Process involves...

- Engaging the Target Population in Pre-Screening for *Risk Identification*
- Conducting Full Assessment for *Risk Intensity*
- Applying Appropriate Intervention based on risk:
 - Basic Education for *No Risk*
 - Brief Intervention for *Low Risk*
 - Brief Treatment for *Moderate Risk*
 - Referral to Treatment for *Moderate To High Risk*
